To all CSEA 9200 members:

As you know, as part of the proposed 2010 Westchester County budget, CSEA 9200 members have been asked to accept a "furlough" of 5 days. This would be 5 (five) days away from work without pay (one day per month for 5 consecutive months). Per the proposal, when a CSEA member later resigns, retires, or otherwise leaves County employment ("separation"), the employee will then be paid for the 5 days at the salary rate in effect at that time.

At this time, CSEA cannot and will not renegotiate our contract, especially after finally achieving a settlement after almost 3 years of negotiation.

CSEA 9200 would like to work with Westchester County to come up with good alternative ideas to decrease the 2010 budget. As taxpayers and as professionals at work, we know what methods, purchases, or contracts could be streamlined, changed, or eliminated to produce savings for the taxpayers from our areas of responsibility.
