Beginning February 17, 2009, Nominating Petitions will be available. The positions to be elected are listed below:

Nomination Petition Request Forms are available from Election Committee members Joseph Castellano, Rita Majdanski no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 13, 2009.

To be eligible to seek office, a member must meet the following requirements:

Be at least 18 years of age;

Be a member in good standing of Local 860 Unit 9200 since June 1 of the year preceding (before) the election;

Shall not be a member of a competing labor association or union since June 1 of the year preceding (before) the election;

Shall not currently be serving a disciplinary penalty imposed by the Judicial Board of the CSEA.

A member who is otherwise eligible may qualify as a candidate by submitting a Nominating Petition carrying the signatures and the last four (4) digits of the social security numbers, along with the first initial of the last name of not less than 200 members of Local 860 Unit 9200 eligible to vote in the election.

All ballots mailed during the course of this election will be mailed according to the membership records of the CSEA, Local 1000/AFSCME, AFL-CIO as of April 1st, of the election year.

Any member believing himself/herself aggrieved by any aspect of the election process may file a written protest postmarked within ten (10) calendar days after the member knew or should have known of the act or omission regarding which they are complaining.

The written protest must be sent to the appropriate supervising Election Committee as set forth below, by certified mail, return receipt request. The Supervising Election Committee will send all other candidates affected by the protest a copy of the protest and give adequate time for responses.
