Dear Sir or Madam:

Thank you for participating in the 13th Annual White Plains St. Patrick's Day Parade, scheduled for:

Saturday, March 13, at Noon. **This Parade is rain, snow or shine!**

The following Parade guidelines will assist you with the event:

1.) Group Leader – Check in by 11:15am at the check-in table on Mamaroneck Avenue at Waller Avenue by former Sunoco Station. (Your group members may arrive up to 11:30am.) Look for Committee Members in Sashes.

2.) Parade Marchers – Drop off at Mamaroneck Avenue at Rutherford Avenue (TD Bank) (for Divisions 1 or 2) and at Bloomingdale Road (Divisions 3-5).

Parking for Cars – Available in the Chester/Maple and in the Hamilton Avenue/Main Street Parking Garages.*

* **Please send an email to jkamna@allny.com if you would like us to mail parking passes to you. These are limited to 4 per band/group so please carpool if possible.**

All Buses/Bands – Enter off Bryant Avenue to Old Mamaroneck Road to drop off Band Members on corner of Old Mamaroneck Road no later than 11:15am. Then proceed down Mamaroneck Avenue to Main Street and left onto Conroy Drive to park until the parade ends.

- **All Parade Floats should enter line up area of Bloomingdale Road to Mamaroneck Avenue.**

3.) The Parade Route begins at the corner of Old Mamaroneck Road and Mamaroneck Avenue, proceeding down Mamaroneck Avenue to Main Street, ending just past City Hall – the reviewing stand will be on the steps of City Hall, so feel free to salute dignitaries, but **DO NOT STOP**. Estimated Parade length is 60 minutes.

- Make sure to leave 25' space between each group when marching.
- Adults, when walking with youth groups, let youths march in front of adults for safety.
- Please do not throw giveaway items.

4.) Parade held rain or shine – **ONLY** in the event of a major storm, parade may be canceled. Listen to WFAS-1230AM for any cancellation information or call (914) 686-0239 as of 9:00am for a recorded message.

5.) Please come dressed, as there are NO changing facilities available.

6.) Band & Group Award – This year, we will present the Frank McMahon Memorial Grand Marshal's Award to the best band and the Robert Greer Memorial Award to the best group. A Commemorative Award will be presented to the winners post-parade.
